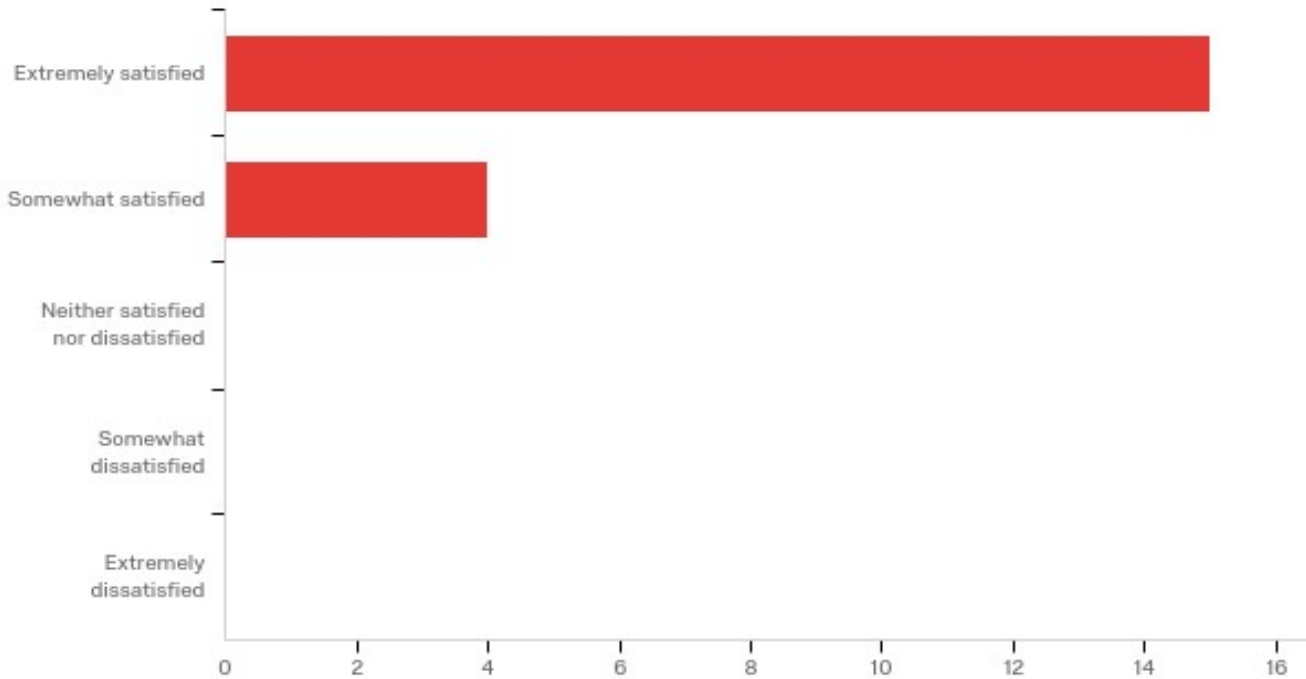

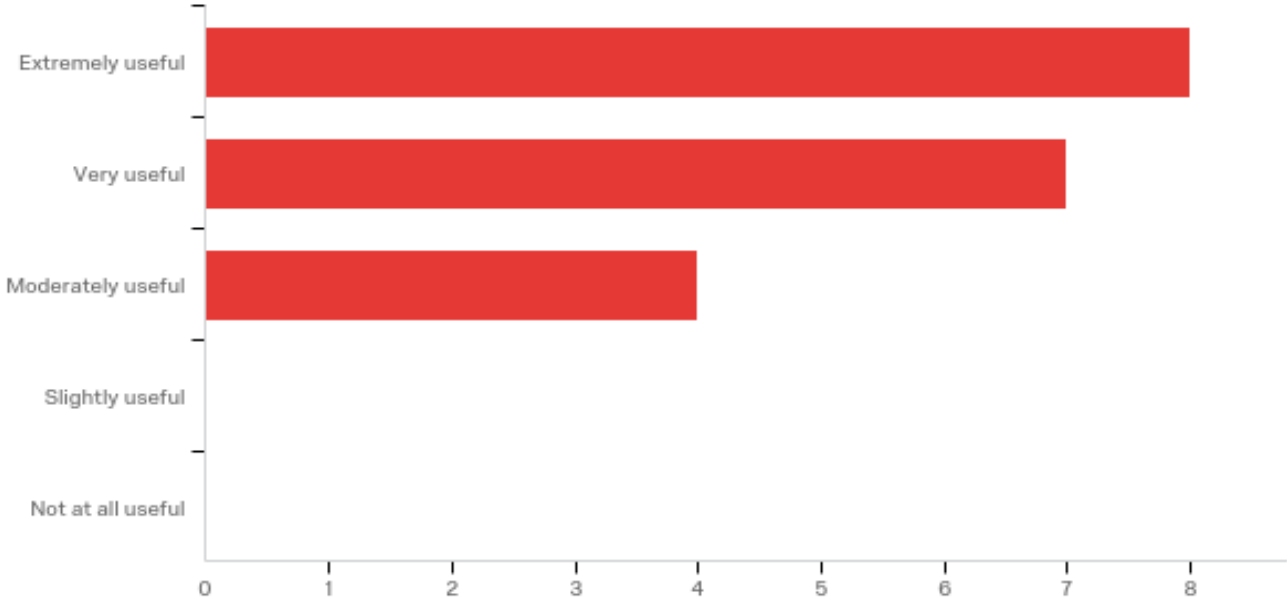

Q2 - How satisfied were you with the overall meeting experience?



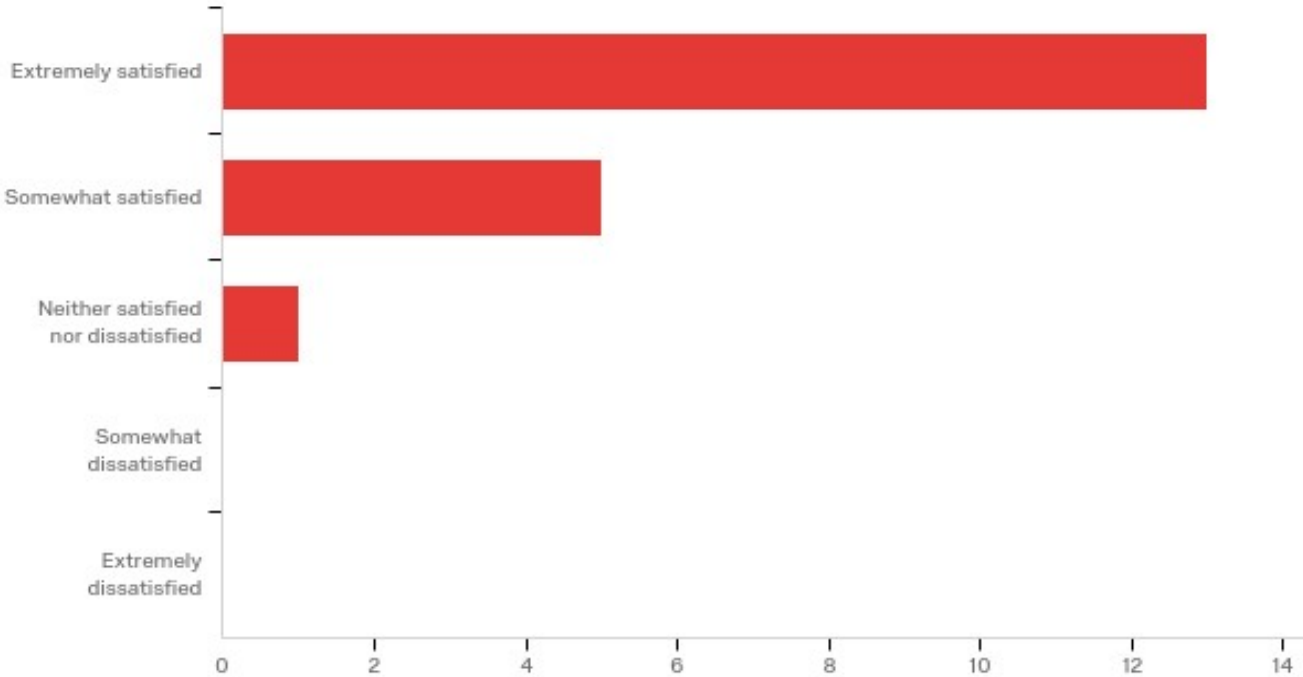

Q3 - Overall, how useful was the meeting to your work in injury and violence prevention?



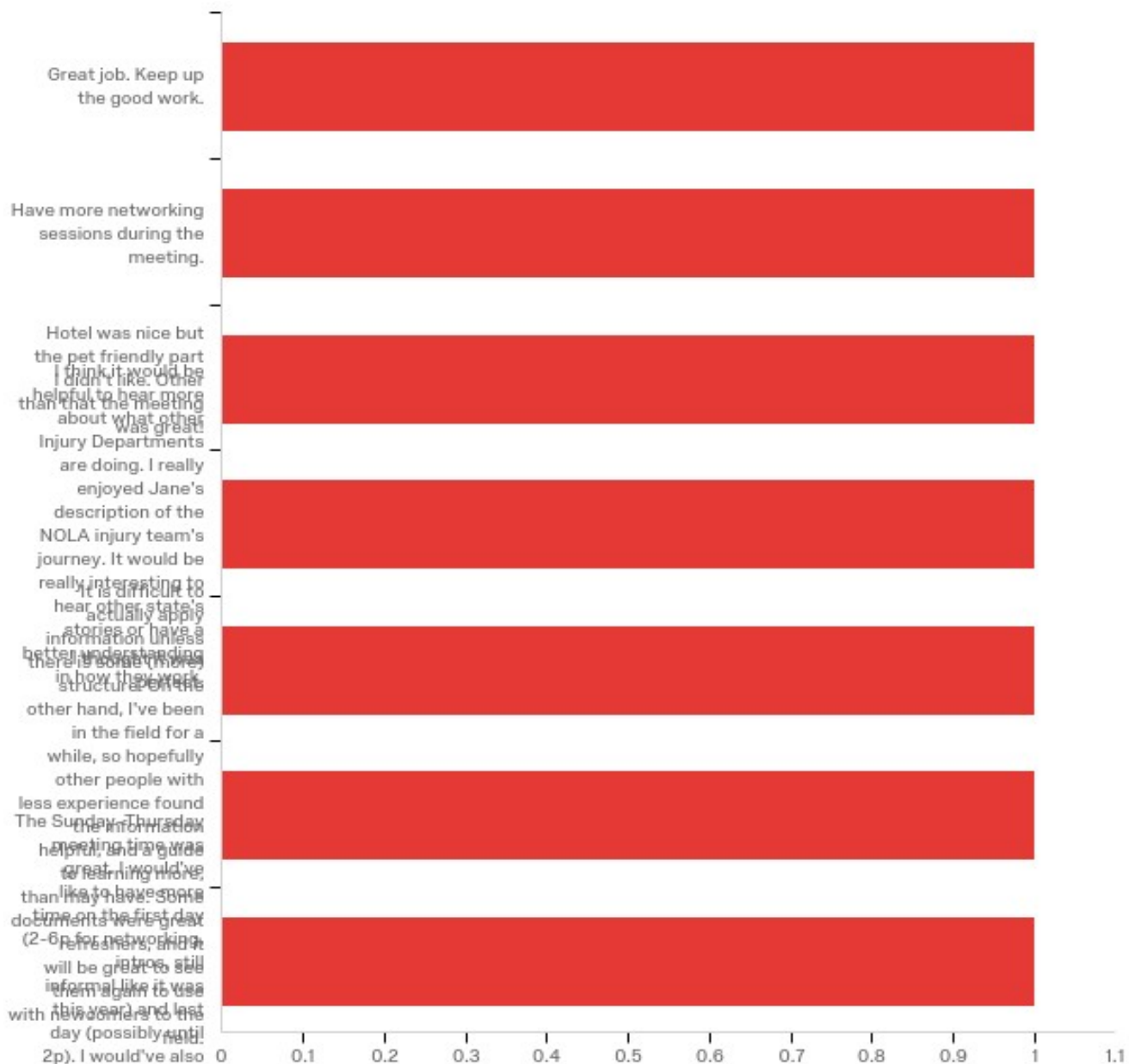

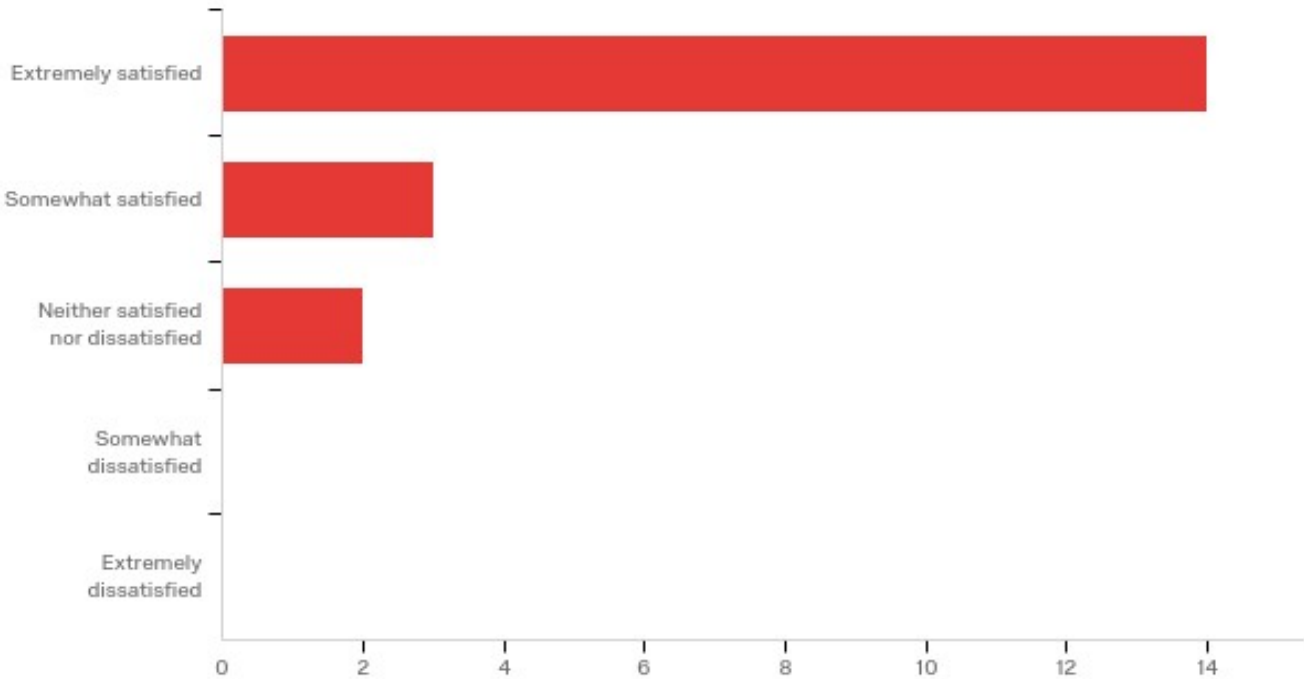

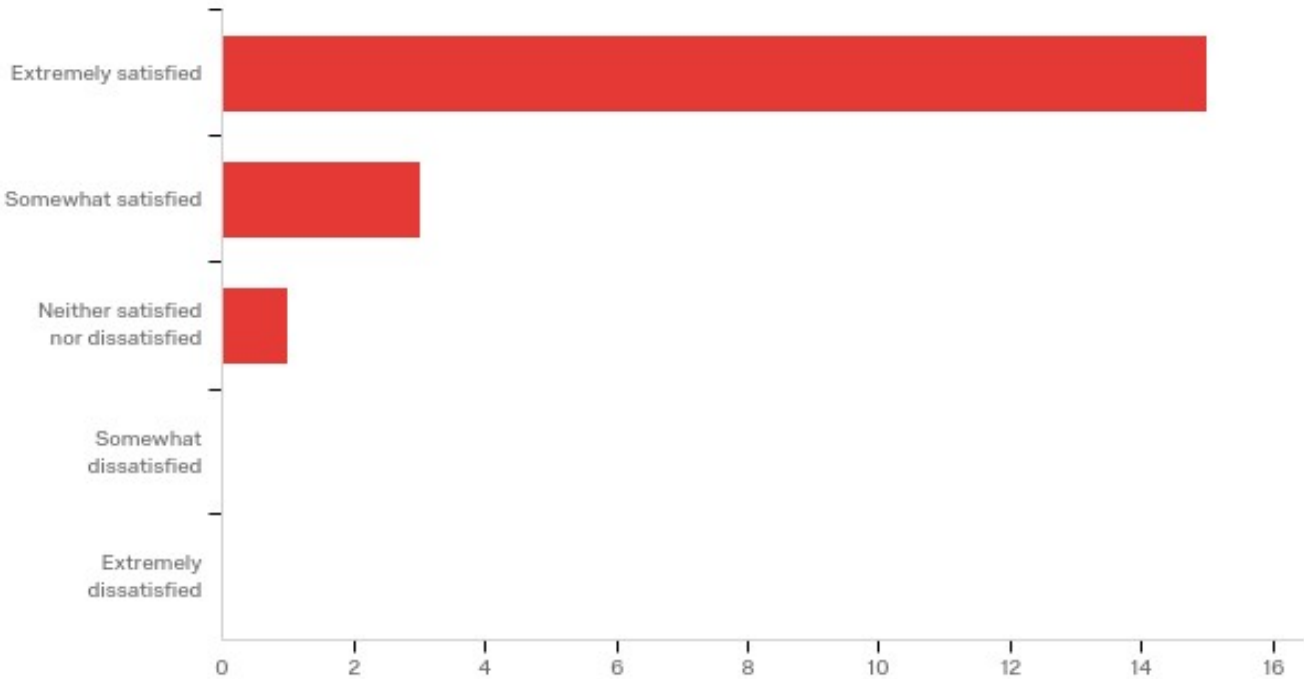

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Q12 - How satisfied were you with the presentation by Avy Redus of Oklahoma's Naloxone Evaluation?



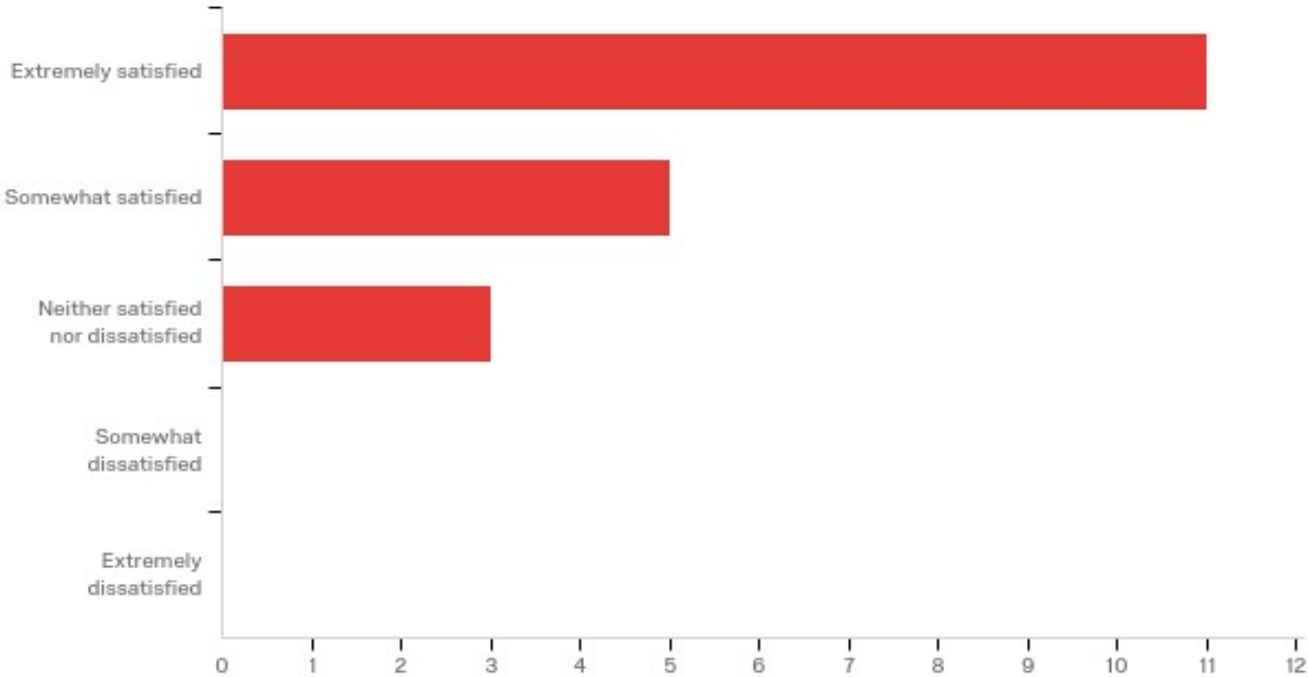

Q13 - How satisfied were you with the presentation by Jennifer Woody of Overview of Systems Thinking and Future Plans?



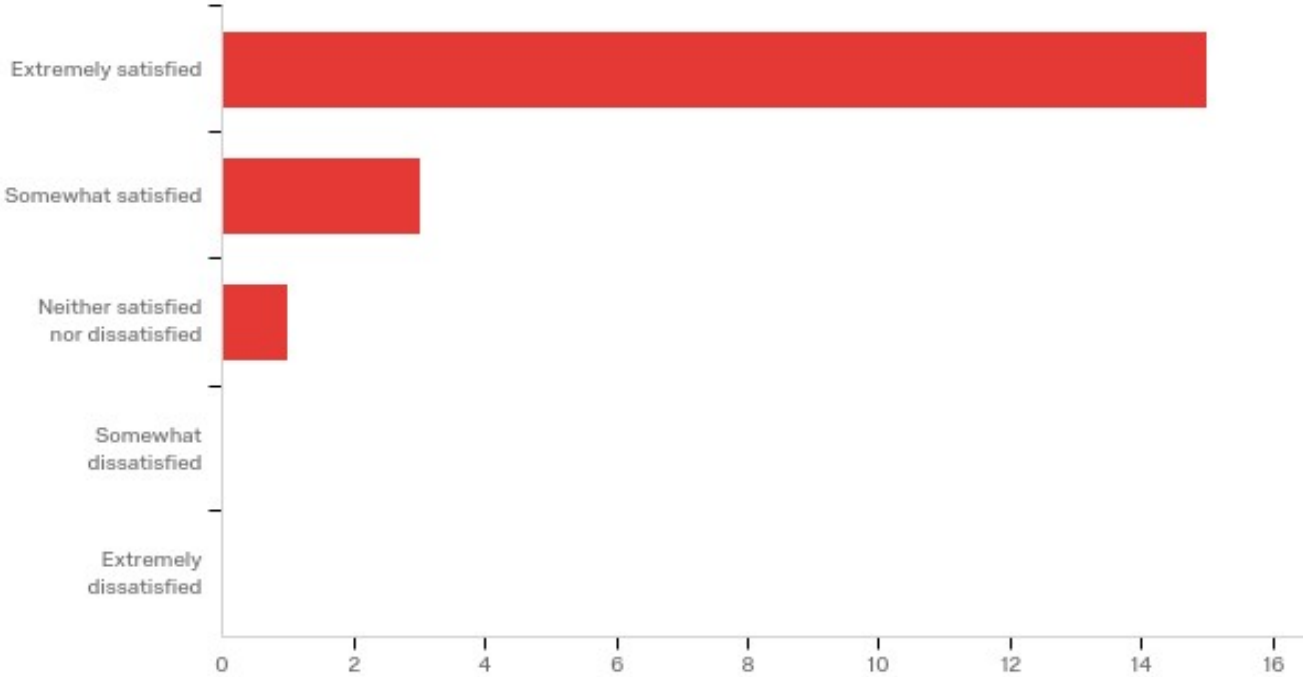

Q14 - How satisfied were you with the presentation by Jane Herwehe of Louisiana's Story of Building an Injury Prevention Program?



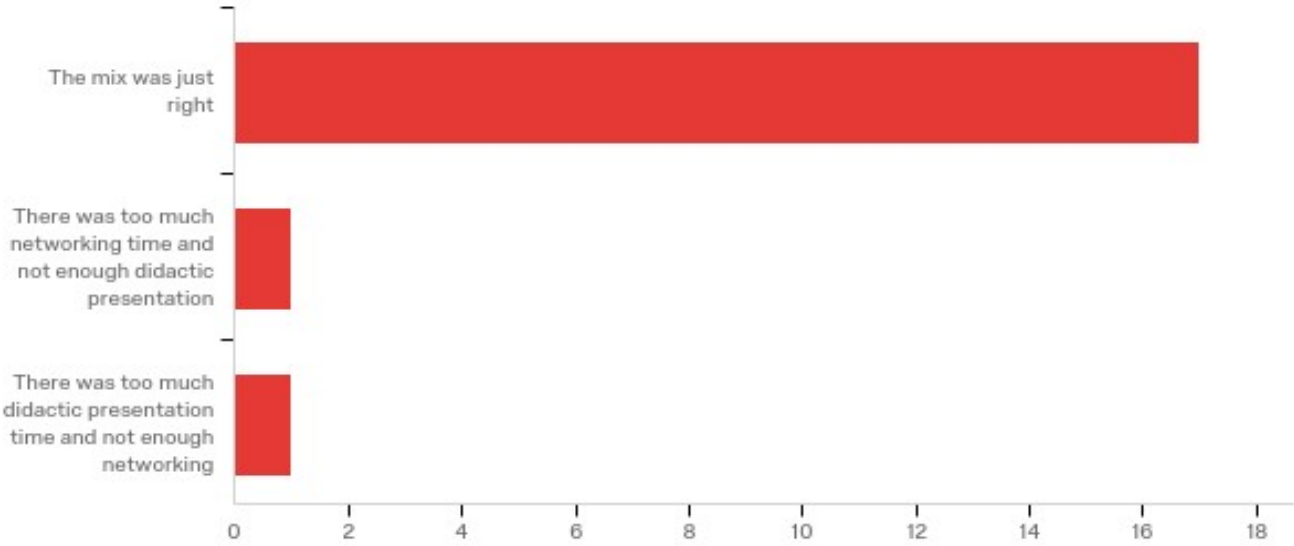

Q6 - How satisfied were you with meals provided during the meeting?



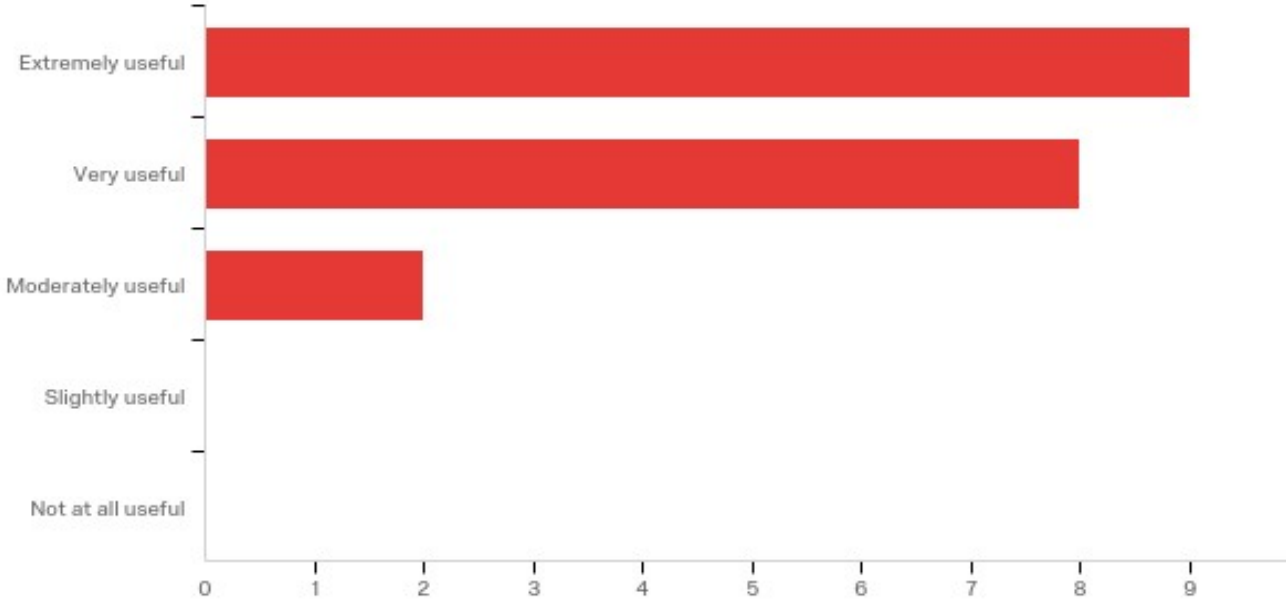

Q15 - What do you think about the mix of networking and didactic/presentation time at the meeting?



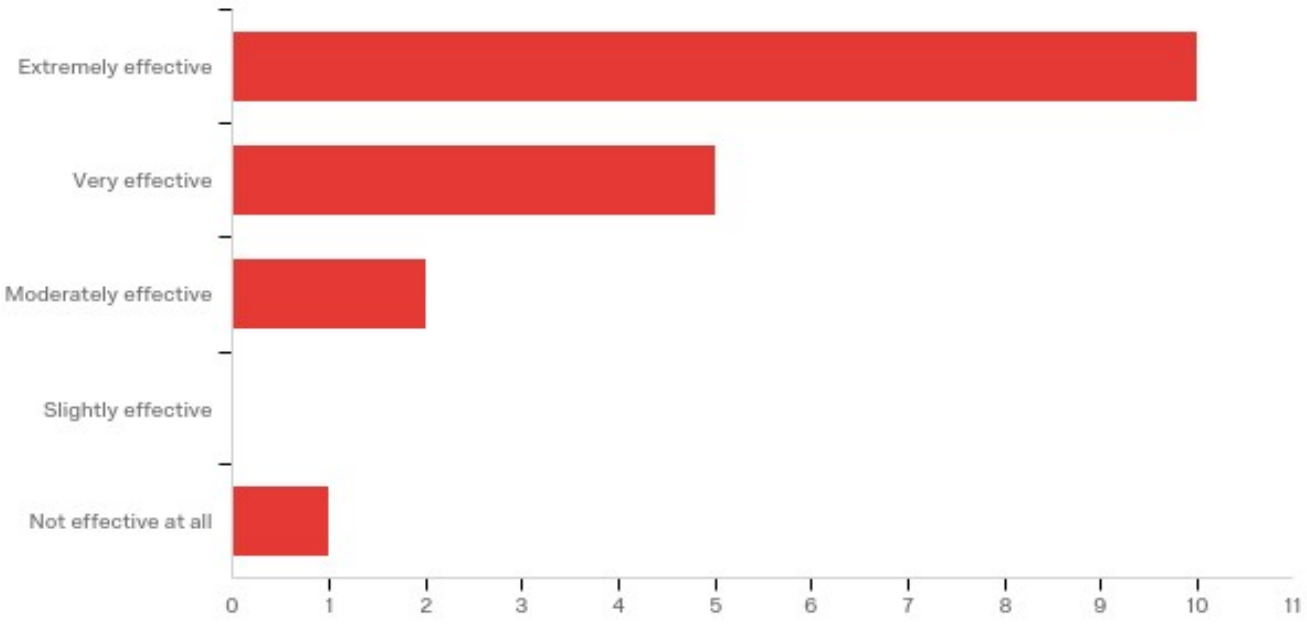

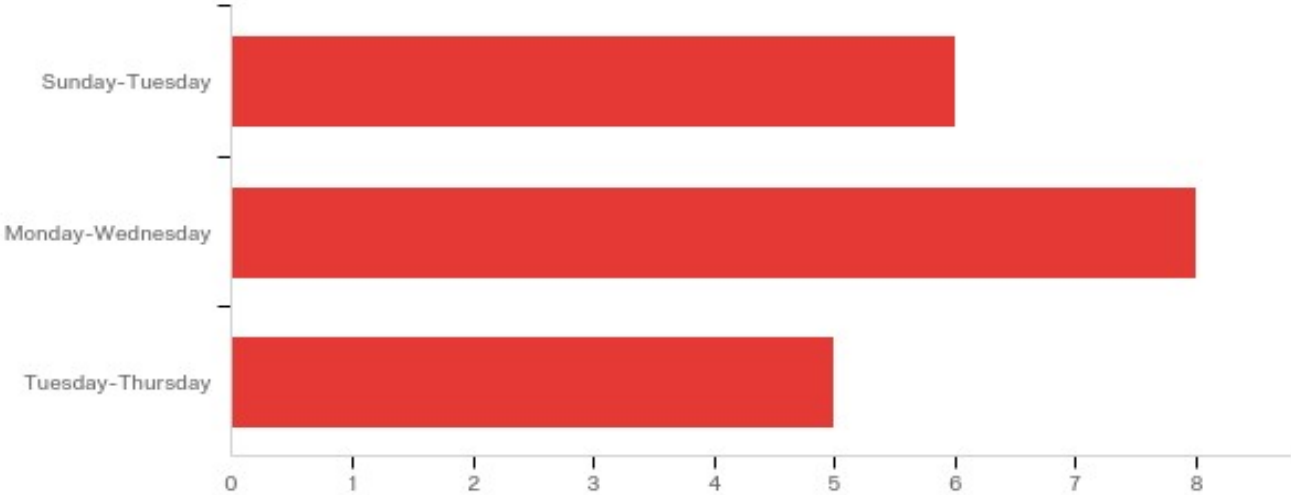
Great intersection to our work!
